Scholarship Criteria:

The recipient must be an active member of TCEC, the spouse of an active member or the child or
grandchild of an active member, if the child or grandchild lives in the Cooperative's service territory.
Employees and members of the Board of Trustees or their relatives are <u>not</u> eligible.
The recipient must be enrolled in an accredited program, either full-time or part time.
The recipient must be an undergraduate student only.
The scholarship fund will be in the form of a grant program with funds being paid to the college,
university, or vocational school.
A person may submit an application each year, but previous winners are not eligible for a second
scholarship.
The scholarship fund will provide up to \$2,000 for each scholarship winner's education expenses. The
number of scholarships awarded will depend on the fund earnings.
Scholarship use must commence within one year of date of issuance and be totally utilized within two
years of the date of issuance.
The scholarship may be used at any two-year or four-year accredited college or university in Florida
including vocational schools.
A combination of need, academic ability and community contributions will be used in determining
scholarship winners.
An appointed committee will judge scholarship applications.

- 2. Transcript from high school
- 3. Formal letter with reference to future plans, goals, community involvement and reason for applying for the scholarship.
- 4. A 500-word essay on one of two topics.
 - a. Why are electric cooperative still relevant today?
 - b. What can electric cooperatives do to help improve quality of life for our community?
